The United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada offers a scholarship of \$2500.00 annual to a Graduate Student (MA – 2 years, PhD – 3 years).

The Student's research must be in the area of Loyalist History and must produce a dissertation that would benefit the Association. A copy of the completed dissertation must be lodged with the Association at the termination of the scholarship.

To be eligible:

1. the student must have taken Canadian History courses in an undergraduate program;
2. the student must have proof that he/she is registered in a graduate program of study at one of the following accredited Canadian universities: University of New Brunswick, Queens University, York University and the University of Toronto.
3. the student must intend to use the award in the academic year following the receipt of the award and use the money for fees and books;
4. the student must provide a written succinct research proposal to the United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada Scholarship Committee in which he/she sets forth his/her interest in the Loyalists before donation of the award. An interview may be scheduled.
5. priority will be given to a student of proven Loyalist descent.

The United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada reserves the right to award the Scholarship in accordance with its sole discretion.
